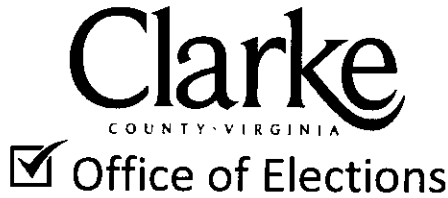

**Meeting of the Clarke County Electoral Board  
Wednesday, August 31, 2022  
Board of Supervisors' Room**

1. The meeting was called to order at 9:01 AM by Chair Daryl Glenney.
  - Other members present were Kelly Johnson, Vice Chair, Carol Westervelt, Secretary,
  - Barbara Bosserman, General Registrar.
  - Mary Ivey was also present as an observer.
2. The proposed agenda was approved as presented.
3. EB member comments – Daryl is glad to live in Clarke County!
4. The minutes for the July 21, 2022, meeting were approved as presented.
5. November 8, 2022 election:
  - Certification of candidates is complete:
    - Member House of Representatives: 2 candidates
    - Member School Board – Russell District: 2 candidates
    - Member Town Council – Town of Boyce – Special: 1 candidate
    - Member Town Council – Ward 2 – Town of Berryville: 1 candidate
    - Member Town Council – Ward 4 – Town of Berryville: 1 candidate
    - Vice Mayor – Town of Berryville: 1 candidate
  - Ballot order: 11,984 ballots (98%) have been ordered and are in the process of being printed.
    - The ballots will be coded by precinct/style so Central Absentee Precinct can report the results by precinct.
    - There will be 17 ballots styles for the November 8 election.

7. Barbara informed us that she has received several Freedom of Information requests. Some of the requests are from out of state. She is following the guidelines for responding to valid requests.
8. Redistricting, including town of Berryville, is complete. Richmond will be sending notices to EVERY Virginia voter. The notice will include the local election district(s) and polling location along

with Congressional, Senate and House of Delegate districts. Congressional redistricting has caused many to be confused.

9. Board Member Email Policy was tabled.

10. The VEBA District meeting will be September 13<sup>th</sup>, in Warrenton.

11. Miscellaneous:

- There will be a WebX immediately following this meeting concerning Same Day Registration.
- Election Officers training will be November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The chief and assistant chiefs will be held on October 27.
- Because of Veterans Day, the election results will be finalized Monday, November 14<sup>th</sup> afternoon.
