At 9:37 am, Chairman Dodson called the meeting to order.

Approval of Agenda

Services Report

They will be able to carry a full caseload allowing Tucker Ryan to focus solely on Foster Care. Alex Herrera is currently listed as secondary on most cases and is still training in CPS.

Ms. Parker recognized the services team for working together during a particularly difficult CPS case in the beginning of May.

Benefits Reports

Caitlin Williams started as the new Benefit Programs Specialist II from Warren County on May 22nd. She will be assisting Tiffany with training and case readings/authorizations. With the PHE ending, Tiffany explained that staff had been given strict guidance not to close any cases until the end of May. The workers were giving clients notice before cut-off.

Ms. Parker presented the FY24 Compensation Plan. The only changes made was the decrease in probationary increases to 3% and the critical skills decrease to 3%.

Director's Update

The agency has purchased the security cameras and are currently waiting on installation. Signs will be posted informing clients and staff that recording is in progress. Ms. Parker also briefed the Board that the agency now has a special emergency text alert for all staff that Lane Carter will be responsible for.

Human Services Assistant III, Tina Maseda's last day is May 26th. This led to a discussion of exit interviews which the state does not allow. The Board reminded Ms. Parker to let staff know that they are available.


