Call to Order

At 9:30 am, Chairman Dodson called the meeting to order.

Services Report

Sarita Emmons had brought APS cases down to two and AS cases to 6. Mandy Smulik has taken over the In-Home Services caseload. There are two adoption cases that Mr. Austin is hoping to have completed by the end of summer. Mr. York mentioned the importance of ensuring that citizens knew what each program in Services was intended for. Ms. Parker suggested speaking to the county about rearranging their website to help clients/citizens better navigate each program area.

Benefits Reports

Tiffany Lee explained that many clients are submitting their renewals however the eligibility team has begun closing Medicaid cases. She also gave a quick breakdown of how VIEW funding was spent in FY23. \$50.00 gas cards were purchased for clients to use for transportation to and from work, car repairs were paid for and rental assistance was provided for one client. It was suggested that a class be held on professional etiquette for VIEW clients.

Director's Update

The new Human Services Assistant will be starting July 5th and the Office Associate posting will be posted June 23-June 30.

There will be a full staff meeting on June 30^{th.} The next staff meeting will be at the end of August and the agency will have a "Mental Health Day" where staff participates in Fatigue Compassion Training conducted by another DSS Director. This day will also be used to try some team building exercises and have a staff luncheon. The agency will be switching cleaning services effective July 1st.
