# I-A CURRENT VERSIONS OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE, SUBDIVISION ORDINANCE, DEFINITIONS, AND GUIDANCE MANUAL

#### **Zoning Ordinance, Subdivision Ordinance, and Definitions Article**

The <u>Zoning Ordinance (Article I)</u>, <u>Subdivision Ordinance (Article II)</u>, and <u>Definitions</u>
<u>Article (Article III)</u> are components of the <u>Code of Clarke County</u> and are amended from time to time as initiated by the Planning Commission or Board of Supervisors. The most current version of each is posted to the Clarke County website (<u>www.clarkecounty.gov</u>) and a limited number of hard copies are available in the Department of Planning for purchase.

As text amendments are adopted during the year, they are posted to the County website and are included with hard copies purchased in the Department of Planning. On an annual basis typically in January, Planning Staff updates the Ordinances by incorporating the previous year's text amendments and noting the changes in the appendix section of each Ordinance. Adopted text amendments are described in each appendix including their case number reference, title, and affected Ordinance sections. The most current version of each Ordinance will be the version dated as the current year along with any text amendments that are adopted throughout that year.

#### **Guidance Manual**

The Guidance Manual is a companion document to the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances and is designed to present regulations, processes, and other important information in a customer-friendly format for citizens, business owners, and design professionals. Planning Staff updates the Guidance Manual at least once a year in January at the same time the Ordinances are updated. The Guidance Manual may be updated during the year as Planning Staff develops new forms, requirements, or enhancements. The most current version of the Guidance Manual will always be available on the County website and in hard copy for purchase in the Department of Planning.

#### **Related Ordinances**

Several ordinances that are related to zoning and subdivision processes are also found in the <u>Code of Clarke County</u> and are amended from time to time but not annually as with the Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances. Some are posted individually on the County website and others are
