

## **FORM Definition of Complete and Incomplete Onsite Sewage Disposal Records**

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### **COMPLETE RECORDS:**

#### Records from 1958 – 1982:

There are TWO documents that MUST be present for a “Complete Record” –

1.) PERMIT TO INSTALL OR REPAIR - WATER SUPPLY - SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM

(AND)

2.) RECORD OF INSPECTION – SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM

#### Records from 1982 – Present:

There is ONE document that MUST be present for a “Complete Record” –

1.) SEWAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEM OPERATIONS PERMIT

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### **INCOMPLETE RECORDS:**

An incomplete record does not satisfy the above requirements completely.

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### **NOTES:**

1.) All limitations on records prior to 1982 are specified in the actual record.

2.) All records after 1982 may specify one or a combination of these three limitations;

(A.) Gallons per Day, (B.) Number of Bedrooms, (C) Number of Occupants.

Unless otherwise noted on records, 1 Bedroom = 150 gallons per day = 2 occupants

\*The responsibility of recording accurate documentation rests solely with the land owner.
