

- 1. Mr. Lawrence made a motion to approve the agenda. The motion was passed with all in favor.
- 2. Public Comment None
- 3. Mr. Hoff made a motion to approve the November 12th, 2020 minutes. The motion was passed with all in favor.
- 4. Committee Reports
 - Standards Mr. Lichty reviewed with the group. It was agreed upon to remove graphs 4, 5, 7 and 8 from future packets. Mr. Lichty noted that the titles of the graphs on pages 20 and 21 were labeled incorrectly and he will adjust those accordingly. No other comments or questions.

- Blue Ridge Mr. Grubb read his memorandum included in the packet to the Commission and mentioned that Director Lichty is also trying to work with other localities to potentially obtain used cylinders. Mr. Grubb supplied the following quote from Municipal Emergency Services.



■ Boyce – Mr. Conrad read the stipend increase request included in the packet to the Commission. Mr. Lawrence inquired if Boyce's paid staff consists of 1 person on duty for 12 hours, 7 days a week and Mr. Conrad confirmed. Mr. Beatty asked if there was any consideration to ask the County for part time staffing. can do it cheaper than the County can and have been doing it that way for quite a while. Mr. Conrad mentioned that he could be present at the Finance Committee meeting in February to answer any questions if they were to arise there.

5. Unfinished Business

- Incentive program review Mr. Lichty reviewed with the group. No comments or questions.
- Communications/Succession Document-Final Draft (see previous documents) Postponed until further notice.
- OT Report Mr. Lichty reviewed with the group. No comments or questions.
- Blue Ridge Staffing update Mr. Lichty reviewed with the group and mentioned that the Finance Committee has recommended to the BOS to continue the staffing. Ms. Harrison inquired that if it is not approved by the BOS then it will stop? Mr. Lichty confirmed and remarked that the part time employees hired for the staffing request had all signed letters with knowledge that the positions could cease at any time after December 31, 2020.
- 6. Report from the Director of Fire and EMS Mr. Lichty reviewed with the group. Discussion-No comments or questions.
- 7. New Business Mr. Hoff requested an update from Mr. Lichty on Warren County Co 6 if they are relocating; understands there have been some extended call times. Mr. Lichty indicated the response times are heading up and in the wrong direction for Box 402. Warren's unit continues to be called out to Front Royal making them unavailable for Clarke. There have been adjustments made to dispatching calls to help improve the situation. Many questions are not being answered until the new Chief comes aboard. Mr. Lichty has a meeting with Warren County tomorrow and is hoping to obtain more information then. Mr. Hoff mentioned that Boyce is preparing to re-inherit the 402 box. He also indicated that Boyce voted last night to purchase a used short wheel base pumper with four wheel drive capability. They have the intention of adding it to the fleet in the next month or two.

- 9. Mr. Hoff made a motion to adjourn. The motion was passed with all in favor at 7:31pm.
