## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 143 (SEPTIC SYSTEM ORDINANCE) OF THE CODE OF CLARKE COUNTY (CC-2021-07)

The Clarke County Board of Supervisors will hold a Public Hearing on **Tuesday, December 21, 2021 at 6:30PM** in the Main Meeting Room, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, Berryville-Clarke County Government Center, 101 Chalmers Court, Berryville, Virginia to consider proposed amendments to Code of Clarke County Chapter 143 – Septic System Ordinance.

The purpose of the amendments is to update requirements based on changes to onsite system technology and issues identified by staff and Virginia Department of Health (VDH) personnel. The last major update to the Ordinance was in 2010 in response to changes to the Code of Virginia requiring localities to permit Alternative Septic Systems. Major proposed changes include requiring 100% inspections of all new systems and component replacement of existing systems, and deleting unused or unenforceable sections such as temporary pump and haul.

Any person desiring to speak on the above matter should appear at the Public Hearing on December 21. Written copies of statements and questions are requested but not required.
