#### Call to Order

## **Employee Introduction**

Ms. Grosholz is Benefit Program Specialist II who came to the agency two years ago. She started at Frederick County Social Services as a Human Services Assistant and worked there for nine years.

# Services Report

Mr. Austin explained there were more Adult Services cases coming in and more Covid funds were being used to purchase wheelchair ramps and hospital beds. Mr. Austin and the rest of the services team are working hard on expanding partnerships with community resources. The services team was also the second highest agency in the state with opening in home services cases. Justin Gerometta was able to figure out that eight citizens were able to be assisted by social services even though they did not qualify for services by taking advantage of local resources.

### Benefits Reports

Ms. Evans informed the Board that case counts were on track with the previous month. On June 15<sup>th</sup>, cooling assistance will begin. During a recent readiness call, staff was informed that a letter was mass mailed to all Medicaid recipients asking for updated demographic information. This will help pave the way for when the

Public Health Emergency ends and agencies will be required to process renewals. The two newest Benefit
Program Specialist are currently enrolled in Medicaid and VaCMS training and will be taking on a small
caseload once these are completed. Tiffany Lee is continuing to reach out to new vendors and resources to help
VIEW/TANF clients.
Comp Plan
Ms. Parker informed the Board that although the State had not approved their budget the county was able to
approve theirs and the six perfect increase for employee salaries was approved. The agency's Comp Plan was
not revised from the previous year however Ms. Parker did explain that she would like to decrease the
probationary increase to three percent in the next fiscal year. Motion by Barbara Byrd seconded by Robin York,
the Board, by voice vote, voted unanimously to approve the FY 23 Compensation Plan.
Strategic Plan
The last strategic session will be held on April 29th at 9:30. Mr. Morley and Ms. Parker will send out reports
and more information as the date gets closer.
Update
Mr. Lawrence informed the Board that at the Board of Supervisors meeting, Chris Boies was designated by the
Board of Supervisors to be the County's ADA Coordinator. He will be the point of contact for individuals with
disabilities to make requests, accommodations or file complaints.
